GRAT SUBSTITUTION raced three wide into the first turn, set a pressured pace, drew clear in the second turn and held on late. VISION OF ROSES raced evenly early, gained ground steadily, rallied four wide into the stretch and closed fast late. ROLLETTI raced three wide in the first turn, pressed the pace but weakened then rallied into the stretch and closed late. CELTIC TOUCH was slow early, gained steadily to the outside, rallied three wide and finished well. EAGLE TWO HUNDRED pressed on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. BOULDER HAT broke well, dropped back on the rail and finished evenly. GREAT ANNOUNCER stalked the pace evenly, closed in the second turn but flattened out in the stretch. COUNTDOWN AT CAPE lacked speed, trailed early, showed little. VICTOR MAN lacked early speed, raced evenly but gave way in the second turn and trailed.
