Footnotes

ILLEGAL WHISKEY was two wide, took the lead, duelled for front in the second turn, cleared in the backstretch and drew off. TAYLOR'S TALE was three wide early, then continued to chase from the outside, gained in the backstretch, rallied in the last turn and closed well. SHANS VICTOR was five wide in the first turn, gained ground from the outside in the backstretch, bid four wide in the stretch and finished well. BILLYREA got away well, raced from the rail, followed the leaders around the second turn chased the field down the backstretch, gained in the last turn and rallied in the stretch. SHADY MOOSE had a slow start, trailed until the last turn and passed tired rivals. GEE IM JOE broke well, raced from the rail, chased in the backstretch, gained in the last turn, was two wide in the stretch and gave a mild rally. SLEEK JOHN stayed on the rail, vied between horses, held his position in the backstretch and gave way in the last turn. A PROMISE MADE was taken back, went two wide in the first turn, followed the field, faded in the backstretch and was not a factor.
