BRAHMS BEAUTY raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the backstretch, made a bid at the quarter pole, led in the upper stretch and drew clear in mid stretch. YOU AND ME BABY broke in the air, raced to the outside, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied three wide and finished second best. BRIARS FLASH was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide and finished well. SUPER STARBRITE set the pace but weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. TIFFANY CHIC dropped back early, trailed and passed tiring rivals. INJIA raced close up on the rail, weakened in the second turn and dropped back. IBEGYERPARDON pressed the pace to the outside but weakened in the second turn and gave way.
