BOULDER HAT raced three wide early, contended on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide and closed steadily. CLASSIC DRUMMER stalked on the rail, made a bid in the second turn, rallied, closed, led late but failed to last. HOWSITGOINGHOTSHOT was slow early, raced evenly then gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide and finished well. MOCHA JOHN raced three wide early, moved to the rail in the backstretch, rallied three wide into the stretch but weakened. CALL ME TOMORROW raced four wide into the first turn, ran evenly, rallied four wide into the stretch and finished evenly. FATHER JONES dueled to the outside but was caught in tight in the upper stretch, was steadied and faded. SUMMER SENSATION dueled on the rail but weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back in the stretch. ECHO BAY dropped back early, saved ground and failed to challenge. FEEDING FRENZY raced to the outside, ran evenly and failed to rally.
