Footnotes

TWO POINT TONY stalked the pace on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and led at mid stretch. TROUBLE N ME set the pace, rallied in the upper stretch but weakened in mid stretch. LONG GONE BALDRY raced evenly on the rail, evenly, rallied three wide in the upper stretch, finished well and closed on place. GLORY BE WILD hesitated at the start and was unsettled early, raced four wide into the first turn, ran evenly then rallied five wide into the stretch and closed well. FIRE THE LIMIT stalked the pace to the outside, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide and faded. CRAFTY BREW was slow early, saved ground and made a mild bid. SHOW ME HOME raced three wide early, raced evenly, rallied five wide in the upper stretch but faded. JACK ATTACK lacked speed, trailed and was no factor. SLASH stalked the pace on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back in the stretch.
