Footnotes

THAT'S A GOOD BOY raced three wide in the first turn, stalked the pace, bid in the upper stretch, dueled and prevailed. ROYAL'S LITTLE MAN set the pace, rallied in the upper stretch, dueled but weakened late. CASH POSITION raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied three wide and gained. BEARSTORM was off slowly, lacked speed and trailed, gained ground steadily, rallied four wide and finished well. ROUGH N' ROWDY raced close up on the rail, rallied into the stretch but flattened out. HARD TO BE HUMBLE stalked the pace on the rail, weakened in the backstretch and finished evenly. HIGH FAVOR was slow early, raced three wide early, ran evenly and was no factor. RIDGELINE saved ground, raced evenly and was never a factor. KUYA stalked the lead to the outside, weakened in the second turn and gave way in the stretch.
