WIZARD IN WINTER lacked early speed, raced evenly, gained ground steadily, rallied into the second turn and closed fast to get up late. SCOOT FOR LOOT broke well, drew clear early, raced evenly but weakened in the stretch and just failed to last. GILDED FOREST raced evenly on the rail, made a mild rally and closed the gap. REBEL THE RED was slow early, raced evenly on the rail and finished well. DANCING THREADS pressed the pace to the outside but weakened in the backstretch and dropped back in the second turn. JOYCE'S CHOICE saved ground, dropped back in the backstretch and finished evenly. TY'S BROOKE stalked the pace to the wide, weakened and chased in the backstretch but gave way in the second turn. LITTLE EINSTEIN lacked speed, trailed and gave way.
