PAPA LOVES ME stayed on the rail, was in the pocket, chase, hard stretch drive and closed in the last strides. THYME IS LIME led, opened up, continued to lead to the head of the stretch and was caught in the last strides. QUINNZ AWAY broke in, closed from the two path, rated two wide, stayed even, slow steady gain, then four wide at the head of the stretch to get show. KIRIDASHI HEAT stalked two wide, remained two wide in the backstretch, weakened at the head of the stretch and held fourth. GYPSY FAIR bumped at the start, stayed on the rail, close to the pace, lost ground and finished even. PENNY BLOSSOM trailed while on the two path, well back at the half and made no impact. TWO PENNY DEED took back, raced even and did not get close. CAROLYN'S BEST was three wide, not far the pace, weakened around the half and dropped back.
