YANKEE CANDY took command, led through out and had an easy victory. CANDY ALLEY took back, trailed, went four wide in the last turn and closed well. RIVER CITY CAT pushed for the front early, was three wide in the first turn, then took a hold to stalk the leader, pushed the leader late in the last turn and weakened in the stretch. YES IT'S JACKIE was three wide early, close up, two wide in the backstretch, pushed hard late and went up the rail for the stretch drive. BONITA BELLA slow start, near the back, stayed even, rally last turn and slowly closed. CLARESIEZIE took out wide suddenly in the first turn, was close up, edged up closer in the backstretch then hung on the outside. LYNN'S FOXIE LADY raced from the rail, was up tight early, slowly lost ground after the half.
