Footnotes

DIAMOND DOC raced evenly, stayed along the rail, had a steady gain, rallied in the upper stretch and closed steadily. ILLEGAL WHISKEY broke sharply, dueled from the outside, stalked, rallied and closed steadily. BIG CHEESE was slow early, raced from the rail, evenly, rallied, got through on the rail in the upper stretch and closed. OFFLEE FANCEE was four wide in the first turn, dropped back, had a steady gain in the backstretch and finished well. BEAR'S ALI raced from the rail, stalked the field, weakened late in the second turn and faded in the stretch. MAYOR MARV stayed along the rail, dueled until the upper stretch and weakened mid stretch. NIKKOA was three wide in the first turn, was gaining, weakened in the backstretch and faded. WAINWRIGHT showed no speed, trailed until the last turn and was no factor. ROYAL'S LITTLE MAN had no speed and was no a threat. CANDLESTICK JACK was five wide in the first turn, raced evenly and trailed in the stretch.
