OBLIGATORY GLORY was four wide in the first turn, raced evenly, gained in the second turn, rallied three wide and closed. SPA FAIRY raced from the rail, set a pressured pace, weakened in the upper stretch and was outfinished. SCOOT FOR LOOT was three wide, pressed the pace, made a bid in the backstretch, dueled late and was outfinished. ASK ALICE was slow early, gained steadily, rallied in the stretch and finished well. PERFECT ECLIPSE broke well, pressed the pace, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. MISS CATERINA was three wide in the first turn, dropped back and was not a factor. OUR NEW TALE drifted in the first turn, trailed and was not a factor. MARFA'S THUNDER raced between rivals early, stayed even and was not a factor. SHY ANGEL saved ground on the rail, was slow early and dropped back in the backstretch.
