SHACKLES N CHAINS raced from the rail, set a pressured pace, rallied and held well. BUD TIME stayed on the rail, contended, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and was second best. RAISE A DANE was slow early, stayed along the rail, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and faded late. PALM DRIVE broke well, was four wide early, dropped back and raced the stretch evenly. SLEWEY was away alertly, stayed on the outside, raced evenly, rallied three wide and faded. NOTIS THE CRIME dropped back early, trailed and showed little. CIRCLE OF TIME was three wide early, pressed the pace, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back. BLOOMING VALLEY was slow early, dropped back in the backstretch and trailed.
