SOLID SOUTH outrun in the early going, advanced four wide far turn, came out a bit when roused turning for home, steady gain, up final strides outside the leader. TOWN STAR took control soon after the start, showed the way up the backstretch while rating, garnered a larger advantage to be clear in the stretch, could not contain the winner. CHALYBEATE SPRINGS prompted the pace while racing outside, briefly challenged in the second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive, comfortably lasted for the show. MAWHINNEY forwardly placed, fell back a bit the middle half, went evenly in the drive in lacking a closing kick. SOUL WINNER'S FIRE lacked speed, came in the two path into the lane, lacked a serious late kick. TOUR DE ROCK pressured the early leader off the inside, vied the middle part, weakened in the drive. HORNET settled off the pace, tired. BROTHER DAY broke in the air, was never close. BARBER SHOP ROCK finished early, fell far back, distanced.
