Footnotes

BIG TALL PAUL broke with the field, allowed the pace to go under restraint, closer second turn, split foes into the stretch, put a head in front with less than a furlong remaining and proved best under a stiff drive. EVADE in the second flight off the inside, ranged up to challenge turning for home, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, could not match strides with the winner, well clear for the place. SUNDAY SUNRISE lacked speed, five wide into the first turn, advanced with a middle move into contention second turn, vied upper stretch and then weakened. LOST FORTY closest to the early leader, moved up to vie before a half, fell back but remained a forward factor through the second turn, had little left for the drive. THATLLEAVEAMARK lacked speed, came four wide out of the final turn, roused for the drive, managed some modest improvement while remaining out in the strip without posing a threat. CHEF ERIC in the three path for six furlongs while well off the pace, 4w into the stretch, failed to muster a rally. STOUT HOPE broke alertly, shook clear early, dueled past the half mid marker, briefly clear again in the second turn, gave way when confronted in the drive. HALO'S THUNDER last away, trailed most of the way, picked off a couple of tiring foes while never a threat. SEGURO wide much of the way, failed to rally. PRIME SPEED staged a steady retreat.
