PEE H DEE broke sharp, raced forwardly in the three path, bothered by a rank RUMORSBOUTME late in the first turn, moved up to vie three wide, hooked up with the runner up for a protracted stretch duel and proved narrowly best in a game effort. Z ROCKSTAR forwardly placed while four wide in the first turn, continued outside, moved up to challenge in the four path second turn, dueled to the wire, outfinished. PLEASANT CLOSING lacked early foot, asked four wide turning for wide turning for home, staged a mild rally turning for home, could do little with the top two, edged clear for the place. BASALT broke through the gate prior to the start, dueled up front off the inside, vied between foes and inside the winner second turn, slowly faded in the drive. RUMORSBOUTME rank in the early going, steadied onto the backstretch, came up empty when asked in the drive. EASTON JACK lacked speed, came five wide out of the final turn, lacked a serious bid. PUTTYKINS last to leave, failed to menace. SPARTAN set or forced the pace while closest to the inside, stopped.
