Weights: 122lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 twice allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 once 5 lbs.; \$15,000 once 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings excluding money won in restricted races. Footnotes

JUNEBUGRED slight bother at the start, rated behind the pace, asked midway in the second turn, traffic with three sixteenths remaining, dropped inside entering the stretch under clever handling, challenged soon after, gained the advantage and then held the runner up safe in the waning strides under brisk handling while drifting out a bit late. RECKLESS JERRY broke well, five wide in the first turn, continued on the outside, five wide again the second turn, lost some ground to the winner who was getting through inside as a result, set down when straightened for home and finished up willingly to be slowly getting to that same foe late. ON FIRE BABY never far back on the outside, four wide onto the backstretch, four wide in the second bend, between foes through the lane when called on for some run, gave ground grudgingly to the top two. JAKE MO broke sharp, pressured the pace while three wide, continued to force the issue in the run up the backstretch, challenged three wide in the second turn, gained a brief advantage turning for home, could not last. LAURIE'S ROCKET broke out, straightened to set the pace in the two path, vied through the second turn, weakened in the late going. OPTIMIZER settled off the pace, continued evenly off the inside, lacked the necessary response in the drive. COPUS lacked early foot, set down for the drive, went evenly through the stretch. PRINCE CHEVAL cut off start, trailed, passed tiring foes while never a serious threat. KING CORAL failed to menace outside. NO SPIN pressured

the leader while attempting to rate, pressed through the second turn, gave way when the real running started at the head of the lane. FASTESTWHOGETSPAID was never involved. HARD NOSED was never close.
