ST. MAWES stalked the pace outside, four wide early turn, bid, drove well clear under steady handling. MARVELOUS PEACE behind the leaders off the rail, held the place. MANDY ON BROADWAY behind the speed, raced three wide early turn, staged a mild rally. TIME TAMER between foes off the pace, improved position slightly in the drive. LIL RUTH well off the pace for a half, showed some belated interest. SHADOWMAKER with the pace along the inside, gave way in the drive. STONESEZ came up empty for the drive. JOANNA'S CORVETTE failed to threaten outside. KODI'S RED ROSE saved ground to no avail. ROSES FOR THE LADY vied up front between foes into the turn, gave way. INDIAN BLUFF pressured the pace outside, gave way. SNOWY PEAK settled between foes, stopped. DENSE FOG OBSCURED INTERNAL POINTS OF CALL.
