BAG TOSSER with the pace while three wide, could not match strides with the winner the final furlong, remained clear for the place. FORTUNE PLAY with the pace while between foes, weakened in the drive, saved the show. JANE'S GAL went evenly paced while off the inside, continued to lace a kick late. LADY DURLYN broke to the inside to bother PINK MARTINI, fell back to trail, passed tiring foes after the issue had been decided. PINK MARTINI steadied, bothered at the start, remained back throughout in lacking a late bid. MEDAL WINNER off the pace and four wide through most of the turn, tired in the drive. BERNT TO RUN backed up through the stretch.
