SQUANDER set the pace toward the inside while firmly in hand, garnered a larger advantage in the far turn, responded when challenged by the runner up entering the stretch, dug in late to prove best. T. C. CHAMP settled off the pace the inside well out in the strip, advanced, challenged outside the winner late in the second turn, outkicked in the late going. MAGNILOQUENT within striking distance, came four wide into the lane, finished up best of the rest. NINTH CLIENT with the pace first turn while three wide, dueled in the run up the backstretch, weakened in the drive. NEW MEXICO pinched back at the start, raced back, improved position while not a serious threat. CATMANTOO settled off the pace, came five wide into the lane, lacked a closing kick. INCALZANDO vied early while between foes, fell back, came up empty in the drive. RED SANDY last away, trailed for five furlongs,not a threat. OKIE TIME saved ground to no avail. DON MISIL (ARG) was finished early.
