LIVI MAKENZIE with the pace from the start along the inside, continued to vie through the turn, narrowly showed the way into the stretch while remaining along the rail, shook clear, held the runner up safe in the late going under firm handling. TRUE last away, advanced four wide into contention turn, lost some ground to the winner into the lane, roused, slowly getting back to that rival late. BID A MOON pushed in a bit after the start, bumped soundly with REMEMBERMEALWAYS, raced back, four wide into the stretch, mild rally. LULU WONG forwardly placed, vied up front three wide and between rivals in the turn, had little left for the drive. TIPPING POINT within striking distanced, shuffled back from between rivals early in the turn, went evenly in the drive. REMEMBERMEALWAYS roughed soon after the start, lacked a late bid. MY SELECTION vied up front off the inside and outside the winner, was giving way late in the turn when in tight, continued to back up in the drive.
