MEEITHER vied up front while between foes into the turn, disposed of the other speed turning for home to get well clear, maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire under steady handling. HONKY TONK SLEW settled off the pace, saved ground through the turn, moved out for the drive, finished willingly midtrack for the place. PRESIDENT'S WOMAN settled off the pace, ranged up three then four wide into the second flight late in the turn, closest to the winner past the furlong marker, caught late for the place. MY PRECIOUS INDIAN off the inside, came into the stretch while between foes turning for home, lacked a late kick. SLINKIN lacked early foot, raced three wide through the turn, made little impact in the drive. INTERESTING PRUNE broke sharp, prompted the pace in the three path, faded in the drive. LADY ANN SUMMERS broke to the outside, straightened and moved up to narrowly set the pace along the inside, gave way. MAGGIE'S DRAWERS failed to menace two path. MY SISTER NORMAN bothered start, tired after a half. DANCING DUDETE shut off start, remained back. PICTURE THIS TUX always back.
