WILL HE THRILL ME closest to the two leaders, continued to stalk early, ranged up to challenge three wide turning for home, quickly shook clear, held the runner up safe late. RAN THE MAN off the pace for a half in the two path, angled out for the drive, closed the gap on the winner when roused, late bid, could not get by. DEVIENT BEHAVIOR alternated up front closest to the inside, raced briefly on equal terms with the winner upper stretch, could not keep up with that foe to the wire nor was he a match for the runner up. TOTAL PACKAGE alternated up front for three furlongs and began to weaken. DREAM COMMANDER last away, raced back, never menaced while racing toward the inside. BUGGS PRIDE tired while racing four wide. RETAP void of early foot, five wide late in the turn, failed to rally. CORN DOG was finished after a half.
