Footnotes

PRIMETIME DREAMER broke alertly, pressed the early leader, dueled through the turn off the inside, shook off the other speed when straightened for home, maintained a daylight advantage to the wire under steady handling. LITTLE BIRD never far back, stalked the pace three wide, called on for some run into the lane, greenly, lugged in when closest to the winner a furlong out, could not get closer while continuing to lug in the final furlong. BULLERO lacked early foot, staged a mild rally on the outside, proved no match for the top two, best of the others. ARKY PEACH devoid of early foot, continued back into the lane, lodged a mild, belated rally through traffic. BO BADGER evenly paced, got out a bit late in the turn, improved slightly in the drive. STONE COUNTY broke alertly but inward to bother two rivals, quickly recovered to set the early pace, showed the way into the turn, dueled middle quarter then gave way when headed by the winner entering the stretch. FRANKS ON FIRE cut off start., trailed, passed mostly tiring rivals. GARNET SILK hesitated a bit at the start, never menaced. THE BAY PHANTOM within striking distance early, faded. LIME RUNNER bothered slightly at the start, gave way. MALLETT five out to six wide turn, fell back, well beaten.
