PACAR allowed the pace to go early, continued under patient handling into the second, got through a large opening when asked a bit turning for home, gained the advantage late and proved best. POLITICAL AGENDA away well, duelled through some rather lively fractions closest to the inside, shook briefly clear when straightened for home, could not contain the winner but proved stubborn to the end to preserve the place. HANDSOME BRUNO broke out, tightened outer foes up at the start, settled in the second flight, asked turning for home, empty drive, preserved the show. BE LIKE MS. D. crowded back at the start, raced back, staged a mild, belated rally up the rail. TOCCET'S CHARM crowded back at the start, lacked speed, improved position toward the inside. NORTHERN CHOICE broke alertly, raced forward, faded in the drive. GRUENEWALD off the pace, was five wide turning for home, failed to rally. WARREN'S DOVE away in good order, alternated up front outside the runner up through some fairly glib fractions and gave way in the drive. INSTILL settled off the pace, had little for the drive. LAKE PLEASANT last away, remained back while racing four wide. CONWAY settled early, tired five wide.
