Footnotes

LIBERTY BULL within striking distance, ranged up to challenge three wide into and through the second turn, came out slightly under a left handed whip when putting a head in front turning for home, switched to a right handed whip while continuing to narrowly hold the lead, back to a left handed stick late, came out slightly, proved best. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. ISABULL three wide first turn when off the pace, moved up to vie four wide through the second turn, brushed by the winner into the stretch, again late, outfinished. RICH YOUNG RULER allowed to settle, behind first flight second turn, no match for the top two, edged clear for the show. INSTILL off a bit slow, settled in the middle of the pace, improved position slightly while off the inside, no real threat. GENERAL LAKE off slow, trailed early while saving ground, improved position by passing some tiring foes, also was not a serious threat to the top three. PONI COLADA narrowly set the pace along the inside, weakened in the drive. GALLANTPROSPECT pinched back at the start, made little impact. SARATOGA SEVEN broke in, moved up quickly to vie three wide, gave way in the drive. JERI HARPER hit gate, broke in, five wide when well back into the stretch, evenly late. YES IT'S BULL showed little in a dull effort. PALMERSTOWN steadily faded. CAPE OF STORMS vied up front between foes and stopped after five furlongs.
