RANSOM ZIP narrowly set the pace while in the three path, larger advantage midstretch, responded when challenged by the runner out outside that one, dug in to prove best. GLOWING REPORT forwardly placed and inside, continued to skim the rail into the lane, rail bid late, denied. SIXTYSIX MARGAUX moved closer four wide turning for home, set down for the drive, hung in the drive. GET BACK KAT went evenly while off the inside. THE LADY RIGALI prompted the pace in the two path, faded in the drive. RUNNING SHOES lacked a closing response. KY HISTORY void of speed, swung out to be five wide out of the turn, failed to rally. PIC THREE BERTIE fractious in the gate, showed little in a dull effort.
