WESLEY MAJOR forward and inside from the start, fell back slightly while continuing to save ground in the turn, set down drive, late bid, proved best in game fashion. SNOW ON THE BAYOU broke out, bumped with foe, advanced and came five into the lane, late bid, missed between foes,, gained the nod for the place. KID YOU NOT lacked speed, came six wide into the stretch when beginning to rally, lugged in after being roused right handed to bother a tiring rivals, finished willingly to miss the nod for the place while widest of the first group. SHARP ANGLE lacked speed, waited briefly behind horses for home, improved a bit in the drive while angling a bit to the inside. HEAVY SURGE broke in, lacked speed came four wide into the stretch, angled out a bit, improved by passing tiring foes. SKIPONBACK forwardly placed outside, was tiring when bothered by KID YOU NOT when that one lugged in midstretch, continued to weaken. MISTER SUH vied up front just off the inside, gave way way in the drive. GEORGE A. with the pace while three wide, also faltered in the drive. NO CHARGEBACK had nothing for the drive. MR. BARRON in tight at the start, was never close. HOLY BULLHIVE has speed for a half and stopped.
