OK NOTHANKSFORASKN moved up inside to show the way into the first turn, set some quick early fractions, shook off the other speed second turn, brief breather, remained clear in the drive under steady handling. GOOD QUESTION allowed to settle off the pace, roused for the drive, split foes, was going well at the end to be up for the place. HAWK ON THE HUNT pressured the winner outside that one, weakened a bit, caught second late. HELLIECAT behind the leader, moved closer on the outside turning for home, hung in the drive. TAMO TIGER off a step slow, trailed early, improved after a half, not a real threat. LUMBERJACK CAT had nothing for the drive. GAME PLAY'S ICON failed to menace while off the inside. ECONOMIC BAILOUT never a factor. COOL LION was finished early.
