CLARE'S PROSPECTOR prompted the pace four wide through the turn, put a head in front nearing the furlong marker, long drive, narrowly best. LATE HIT bothered just after the start, waited behind the first flight while off the inside through the turn, dropped inside for the drive, finished willingly to miss. HALF BLUE bumped start, settled off the pace, swung out to be five wide late in the turn, finished up willingly. WALL CLOUD went evenly paced while off the inside, lacked a late kick. LAKE LUCERNE broke sharp, fell back soon after, raced three wide, improved position while not a serious threat. MISTER EXETERA forwardly placed while three wide, faded in the drive. VALID MYTH bothered at the start, lacked a rally. MIDNIGHT ILLUSION lacked response in the two path. MORENA'S DREAM veered in at the start, never a threat. MR. MACABE broke out, bumped HALF BLUE at the start, remained back throughout. WHAT A PLACE cut off just after the start, trailed most of the way. ZOIE'S RUN had speed for a half, stopped.
