GRAND SENSATION confident handling while off the inside, engaged the leaders late in the turn, edging away while being asked. OATMAN broke alertly, with the pace, gave ground grudgingly to the winner late. GRAND ALIBI lacked early foot, in some traffic between foes late in the turn, four wide into the stretch, finished up willingly to be getting to the runner up. EXPLOSIVE GHAZIE trailed for a half, swung out to be five wide out of the turn, staged some modest late interest well outside. EURO SILVER JET was never dangerous. FIVE ALARM narrowly set the pace toward the inside, gave way. REAL QUIET MAN tired four wide. SARATOGA SEVEN faded three wide.
