DARLIN' DIANE took control up the inside soon after the start, clear before a quarter, bit of a breather turn, held the runner up safe late under steady. INDIAN BEADS closest to the leader, lodged a mild bid turning for home, fell back, coming again late. SHEZALADYANNE lacked speed while off the inside, angled out for the drive, displayed some late interest to be up for the show. DAKOTA DAZZLER also well off the pace, came four wide out of the turn, improved position a bit while not a serious threat. SARIAH within striking distance while four wide through the turn, came up empty for the drive. LOTTERY LASS forwardly placed for a half, faded. PEACE BRIDGE failed to menace. CHARIOT CHAR off slowly, five wide late in the turn when well back, steered to the inside, failed to threaten. SIXTEEN TONS off a bit slow, remained sluggish, trailed far back.
