### Footnotes

LIGHTSTOWN away best of all, set the pace along the inside while rating, not seriously threatened in the drive, kept to pressure. RECOGNIZE settled off the pace while saving ground, some traffic second turn, moved out for the drive, no match for the winner. clear for the place. EN PASSANT off a bit slow, raced back while lacking speed, came four wide out of the final turn, showed some belated interest to be clear of the rest. LANGALEER off the pace, also came four wide into the stretch, went evenly to the wire. LIMESTONE well back early foot, improved position while never dangerous. READY TO THRILL forwardly placed on the outside, tired three wide. UNCLE T had little left for the drive. ANTIQUE CIRCLE closest to the winner for five furlongs, gave way. ARCTIC LOON lacked a rally. CATHYS BREEZE was finished after a half. RUN BIG BUD RUN off step slow, trailed.
