SAND PLUM forwardly placed, challenged three wide turning for home, shook clear, held late under firm handling. GREEN GLORY lacked early foot, moved closer five wide late in the turn, fell back off the winner a bit when straightened for home, roused, finished willingly while slipping between foes. KISS ME CHOCOLATE settled off the pace, came four wide out of the turn when lodging a mild bid, not enough in the late going to hold. PRINCESS BIANCONI broke out, off the pace early toward the inside, in the two path turn, lacked a serious late response. HALO'S REFLECTION vied up front while between foes, weakened in the drive. MISSY BISCUIT last to leave, raced outside, picked off a couple of tiring foes after the issue had been decided. BEAUTIFUL BLISS bothered slightly at the start, moved up to narrowly show the way closest to the inside, gave way in the drive. DANCING FERN steadily faded.
