EVENING REWARD with the pace, narrowly showed the way through the turn while between foes, long drive, determined. AIN'T HE A PISTOL forwardly placed, pressured the issue three wide through the turn, outfinished. KINGSHIP slow leaving, trailed, swung out to be six wide turning for home, belated run down the middle of the strip. COURTING WISDOM settled off the pace, raced in some traffic late in the turn, came in a bit to bother an inner foe midstretch, lacked a serious kick when clear in the drive. STONEY GOLD behind the pace, waited briefly for room late in the turn, went evenly in the drive. LIVE FROM APPOLLO vied up front along the inside, was tiring a bit in midstretch when forced to check up in traffic, did not recover. B. B. MANCINI raced back off the pace, moved somewhat closer three wide and in some traffic turn, no bid in the drive. GEORGE RAY raced off the pace inside, steadied repeatedly along the rail in the far turn, did not rally in the drive. BIG RED RANGER moved closer five wide late in the turn, tired in the drive. AGASTACHE wide trip, finished back.
