### Footnotes

RACING BRAN moved up to duel soon after the start while closest to the inside, put the other speed away when straightened for home, increased advantage. VICTORY NOTION last away, began to move far turn, five wide turning for home, moved out wider for the drive, finished up willingly to be in time for the place. COUNTRY PLACE settled off the pace, moved closer toward the inside exiting the final turn, failed to sustain that advance the final furlong, caught for the place. RIMINI REBEL behind the pace, raced in some traffic turning for home, switched to the outside nearing the furlong marker, displayed a modest amount of late interest. FLY'N LION lacked a response in the drive. KATE'S MAIN MAN forwardly placed for six furlongs, weakened in the drive. NUMISMATIST four wide in the first turn, came five wide out of the second bend, lacked a late kick. HIGH SPIRIT void of early foot, passed tiring foes while not a threat. FOUR TO GO was not a factor. TOBY THE COAL MAN dueled up front outside the winner, stopped in the drive. GOLDEN CHAPEL four wide in the first turn, fell back, well beaten.
