TURNLEFTATTHELIGHT broke alertly, rated behind the pace off the inside, continued to race behind the pace under patient handling late in the final turn, in tight turn with a furlong remaining, roused when clear, in time. GOOD QUESTION prompted the pace outside, took over after dueling briefly in the second turn, showed the way past the furlong marker but could not contain the winner. LUMBERJACK CAT in the second flight toward the inside, lacked room midstretch until less than a sixteenth remained, asked between foes, up for the show. WHISKEY MAN got clear before a quarter, set the pace in the run up the backstretch, responded when challenged in the second turn, continued to duel with the winner past the furlong marker, proved stubborn until late. AKA LILY'S LAD pulled hard the first half behind the pace and off the inside, ranged up to challenge four wide late in the final turn, hung in the drive. GO WEST BERT last away, trailed for six furlongs, roused in the three path, lacked a serious kick. PULPIANO gave way late in the final turn, well beaten.
