Footnotes

BLACKBERRY prompted the pace, raced in hand when challenging late in the turn, shook clear when straightened for home, held the runner up safe in the late going. BY DAYLIGHT far back early, moved to the far outside for the drive, too late down the middle of the strip. SALTY N SASSY lacked early foot, roused four wide out of the turn, finished best of the rest. GRACEWITHAPPROVAL also well back early, found best stride too late. AHoy within striking distance, raced four wide through the turn when prompting the pace, came up empty for the drive. EXPENSIVE BABY was not a serious threat. TAKE THE SHIP was not a serious menace while racing off the inside. LITE AND MISTY narrowly set the pace for a half, gave way when headed. LADY HIGH INDY tired. FRISKY ANNE was outrun while wide. BILL'S LADY flashed brief speed and began to fade before a half.
