EVERYTHING'S ROSIE away well, dueled early off the inside, shook off the other speed late in the turn, drew away in the stretch to win ridden out. BUGSY MCCOOL pinched back at the start, settled in the middle of the pack, late run to be clear for the place, no match. BLUE RIBBON AFFAIR stalked the pace outside, closest to the winner past the furlong marker, held the show. FLEET ANNE dueled up front inside the winner for three furlongs, began to weaken late in the turn, faded. SASSY VALLEY GIRL last away, trailed for a half, some belated interest. MAGGIE'S DRAWERS saved ground, in tight while continuing along the rail midstretch, finished up evenly. ROUND ROCK ROAD within striking distance, had nothing for drive. FOREVER GRACE tired outside. C. J. EIGHT wide, outrun.
