Footnotes

CARVE five wide into the first turn, continued outside behind the pace, advanced to challenge four wide turning for home, kicked clear the final furlong under steady handling. K. O. PLUS pulled, rank while getting out a bit in the first turn, stalked up the backstretch, three wide bid late in the second turn, proved no match for the winner late, held sway for the place. BARN KNEE four wide into the first turn, settled in the second flight for the middle half, saved some ground early in the far turn, moved out, angled back in midstretch, finished up best of the rest while outkicked for the place. LIP CRUSHER in tight at the start, fell well back to trail onto the backstretch, five wide exiting the turn when called on for some run, managed a mild rally. ROCKIN ALEX settled off the pace in the two path, four wide into the lane, lacked a late kick. GLASS DARKLY broke on top, set the pace while off the inside, allowed ANALYTIC the rail onto the backstretch, dueled with that rival, gave way in the drive. ANALYTIC moved up inside, dueled up the backstretch and through the final turn, gave way in the drive.
