Footnotes

FORTY NINE WATTS close from the start off the inside, forced the issue three wide up the backstretch, took over in the far turn, quickly clear, increased advantage through the lane under light urging to win ridden out. TED'S FOLLY lacked early foot, raced four wide through the final turn, rallied, no match for the winner, clearly second best. DREAMINOFTHEWIN bumped at the start, raced back, in some traffic in the second turn, staged a mild rally in the drive in the two path to be along for the show. RAPPIN ROBBY showed the way into the first turn toward the inside, continued to set the pace up the backstretch, began to weaken when headed by the winner far turn. B'WANAGOLDMINE lacked speed, moved out, bit closer second turn, failed to muster a late kick when called on in the drive. ATTICUS THE MAN broke in, bumped foe., moved up to race in the second group in a forward position.
