Footnotes

TIS' TIMELESS broke out, bumped, within striking distance just behind the first flight, encountered some traffic late in the turn, steered out widest for room into the stretch, took over and remained comfortably clear the final furlong while under pressure. BROTHER KRIS brushed at the start, raced behind the leaders inside the first group, also raced in traffic late in the turn, got through, could not match the winner late. T. THOMAS settled off the pace came four wide out of the turn, staged a mild rally while not a serious threat. STAGE ROMEO sandwiched at the start, raced back, 4w into lane, displayed a modest amount of late interest. WAIMEA CANYON broke in, bumped, came five wide into the stretch, raced widest to the wire, improved position. WOO PIG SOOBIE dueled up front early, briefly got clear midway on the turn, faltered when confronted in the drive. DIVINE ONE pressured the pace from the outside three wide and then gave way in the drive. SHOMEWHATUWORKKNWIT off a bit slow, failed to menace by passing a few tiring rivals. CAPTAIN RICOCHET brushed at the start, raced well off the pace when five wide through the turn, remained back. SEVEN'S ROSE vied up front in the early going, stopped in the drive from between rivals. IDOWHATIDOCAUSEIDO always outrun.
