NATIVE RULER well off the early pace, advanced and slipped through a large opening toward the inside, gained the advantage then held the runner up comfortably safe in the late going. BIG RED RANGER bothered at the start, raced within striking distance, moved a bit closer four wide turning for home, could not do much with the winner in the late going, well clear for the place. REAL EASY moved closer five wide late in the turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive as he flattened out a bit, best of the others. FATHER TIME broke out and alertly, cleared off the inside, showed the way for a half, was beginning to falter when he allowed the winner the rail turning for home, continued to weaken. SHORTY SMALL last away, trailed for a half, passed some tiring foes. COMMANDER CARSON pressure the leader for a half, weakened. RISEN CHIEF always back. ELITE ETBAUER finished early.
