SALUTING STORMYE lacked early foot, began to advance while in some traffic exiting the turn, angled out for room nearing the furlong marker, was roused smartly right handed, accelerated and won going away down the middle of the strip. HOT SPEED moved out, stalked leaders, took over from the outside in upper stretch, could not match the winner late, clear for the place. HIT IT HARD settled off the pace and the inside, four wide out of the turn, in a bit tight in the late going, up for the show. DENO'S BIRDIE dueled up front closest to the inside, weakened the final furlong. RED THORN bothered start, four wide in the turn, brushed late, missed the show. ALI FRAZIER broke out, quickly straightened, dueled off the inside, weakened in the drive. HIGH HEIR lacked a rally. SOURCE CODE settled in the middle of the pace early, faded in the drive. LAILA'S CHOICE bothered at the start, trailed.
