MUCHO MACHO UNO bobbled then was in tight at the start, raced back, advanced four wide late in the turn, finished with good late energy to be in time. MAYDAY MAN narrowly set the early pace off the inside, shook off the other speed when straightened for home, clear past the furlong marker, could not contain the winner, remained clear for the place. GOOBER broke in, brushed with the winner, moved closer three wide and inside the winner turning for home, flattened out the final furlong, saved the show. LAC SEUL'S DREAM broke sharp, fell back in hand, steadied while being shuffled back midway on the turn, moved out to be four wide into the stretch, finished willingly to be gaining late. T. THOMAS with the early pace along the inside, faded. MOMENTUM INVESTOR forwardly placed after the start, moved to be closest to the winner outside that one in the turn, had little left in the drive. TARPY SAYS settled off the pace, lacked a closing response when asked in the drive. CAPTAIN RICOCHET last to leave, trailed, five wide out of the turn, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never a threat. SLEW SALUTE was always outrun. LEAD prompted the early pace, stopped.
