Footnotes

HIS EYES clear early, relaxed while well clear the middle half, enough left in the late going to hold off the runner up. APACHE GUNSHIP well off the early pace, roused while advancing four wide in the second turn, finished willingly to close the gap but was too late. COSPOROSITY settled off the pace, steady gain outside, could manage only a mild late gain, narrowly best for the show. ROMEO'S BEQUEST broke in, outrun early, in traffic toward the inside late in the second turn, altered to the outside a bit for some room turning for home, some late interest. TIMBER HUNT hard rated and rank early, continued in an even fashion to the end after settling. SIR RABBIT mugged at the start, raced well back and in hand, improved position in the drive with some late interest while never posing a serious threat. REJUVENATE chased early, weakened. ARCD'ANGELI roughed, bobbed at the start, never posed a serious threat. LOOIE THE RED void of speed, picked up a couple of tiring foes. CLASS WITH SASS not a factor. CERULEAN SKY closest to the leader backstretch, gave way in the drive. SAFE TRIP HOME brushed at the start, stopped.
