BIG RAH broke in, slight steady, quickly recovered, pressured the pace outside the early leader, took over turning for home, held the runner up safe in the late going. NOT SO WILD forwardly placed, steadied while waiting behind traffic late in the turn, angled out four wide for room turning for home, could not get the winner late, well clear for the place. BIRD'S EYE VIEW behind the pace, came five wide out of the turn after angling out for room, rallied late to finish up best of the rest. FATHER EUGENE narrowly set the pace for a half toward the inside, weakened in the drive. BAD DISTRICT forwardly placed while out in the strip, four wide entering the stretch, had little for the drive. POPPAS HALF wiped out at the start, trailed for a half, set down for the drive, showed some belated interest through traffic. CHADNJAMIE behind the pace, bell back toward the inside turn, evenly through the stretch. EXTINGUISHED fanned six wide turning for home, came up empty for the drive. Q A'S ROCKET broke out, steadied, fell well back, never involved. SEEKING THE HALO stumbled at the start, failed to menace. FARE CIELO five wide out of the turn, tired in the drive. SING IN THE STORM five wide in the turn, tired.
