NORTHERN VOW off the pace, four wide into the turn, five wide out, challenged when straightened for home, bid, shook well clear. CARUSO prompted the leader while off the inside, challenged between foes, no match late, all out to hold the place. SARATOGA SEVEN in the second group off the inside, steered toward the inside, getting to the runner up. FAIRMONT within striking distance, saved ground through the turn, evenly in the drive. YONA TORY made little impact. LUNARPEAL lacked speed, came into the lane well off the inside, passed tiring foes. NOAH'S TRAVELER showed the way soon after the start, got clear into the turn, weakened when replaced on the lead when straightened for home. TAX AND SPEND slow to start, trailed, was never a threat. JUSTIN forwardly placed in the early going, began a steady retreat before a half.
