Footnotes

LITTLE MONTIE allowed the pace to go early, advanced off the inside late in the final turn, collared the leader soon after, outside bid, drove clear. GOOD FAMILY within striking distance, moved closer toward the inside second turn, no match for winner in the drive, clear for the place. JOLLY OL' NICK chased the leader, moved out, roused for the drive, up for the show in the final strides, no threat to the top two. HOUSE OF USHER quickly cleared to the inside, set the pace while in hand, weakened when confronted in the drive. EPICURUS last to leave, trailed early, made little impact in the drive. DABOSSMAN lacked a rally. WATCH CUPID was finished after a half.
