SWEEP THE NATION settled in the second group, ranged up to challenge three wide in the second turn, showed the way into the lane, clear, enough left late. SLAVE'S RANSOM broke out, lacked speed, circled to the front while five wide into the lane, lost ground to the winner, getting back to that one late. ALLEGED DIVA hard rated off the pace toward the inside, bit closer in traffic second turn, blocked into the lane, moved outside, finished up willingly while too late. BE POLITE off the early pace, loomed closer four wide turning for home inside the runner up, hung in the drive. SHE CAN TANGO TOO settled off the pace, moved a bit closer in traffic in the second turn, lacked a kick in the drive. DUBIOUS void of speed, fanned five wide out of the final turn, went evenly through the stretch. HELLA BELLA three wide much of the way, also lacked a late bid. SALINO forwardly placed along the inside, gave way. NOPI CHICK in tight at the start, not a threat. AGREETOBEGOOD four wide with a bid in the second turn, gave way. LILSTER chased the early leader, gave way after a half. HALF A SPLASH sprinted clear, pace for five furlongs, stopped.
