STAMP outrun in the early going toward the inside, moved out a bit and raced in some traffic late in the turn, moved out a bit further for the drive, outside bid, drove well clear. BAD BIG AL vied up front off the inside, proved no match for the winner, proved game for the place. RANGE WAR pressured the pace off the inside, with the pace while between foes into the lane, also could not match the winner the final furlong, outfinished for the place. WISEMAN'S BLUFF moved up inside to force the issue in the early going, weakened in the drive. GALLOPING GULCH narrowly set the pace along the inside, also faltered in the drive. NORTHERN CHOICE off the pace, came five wide out of the turn, improved position a bit in the drive. SOUL COAXING off slowly while racing toward the inside, made little impact in the drive. SAINT'S RELIC lacked a late bid. BLACK CROSS off slowly, trailed, was never involved. MARQ FRENCH gave way after a half.
